Valentine's Day and Real Love

How can we say, "I love you"? Let me count the ways!

On their wedding anniversary, a husband might give his wife a lovely card and a gift, some flowers, and maybe even a romantic dinner at an upscale restaurant. With them, he is saying, "I love you." On Father's Day, his wife might give him a card and a gift. Likewise, she is telling him that she loves him.

But our society, urged on by the greeting card industry and other merchants, tries to tell us that it is not enough for family members to declare their love for each other on anniversaries, Mother's Day, and Father's Day. You must do it all over again—on Saint Valentine's Day!

But God's people reject this idea; they do not keep Saint Valentine's Day. Why not? We can discover the reasons by answering five questions one by one.

Question 1: Who was Saint Valentine?

"Valentine" was apparently a very popular name among the so-called saints of yesteryear, as history records a considerable number by that name. However, the most famous "Valentines" were two martyrs whose festivals both fall on February 14. Yes, there were two Saint Valentines! Most people never realize that!

One was a Roman priest, while the other was the Bishop of Terni, a town in central Italy. Apparently, these two men had

quite a lot in common: They lived at the same time, around the second half of the third century AD. Moreover, they died on the same day and are supposedly buried along the same street, the Via Flaminia, an ancient Roman road that ran northward from Rome over the Apennine Mountains to the Adriatic Sea. A street seems a strange place for burials of clergymen, but evidently, the Roman Church honored them with monuments along this famous road.

Except for the setting of their feast day, the historical record gives no indication why either of these men is connected with sexual love and romance. Apocryphal accounts say that Saint Valentine secretly married Christian couples against the emperor's command, but the stories originated hundreds of years after both of these men were dead, allegedly to bolster the saint's ties to the Medieval festival in his honor.

This, in a nutshell, is about all we know about the two Saint Valentines. Not much, is it?

Question 2: What are the real origins of the celebration of this day?

As far back as documented history goes, we can trace the celebration to two ancient Roman fertility festivals: a lesser-known one on February 13 called the "Faunalia," in honor of the god Faunus, and the better-known one on February 15 called the "Lupercalia," honoring the god Lupercus. The Romans considered Faunus and Lupercus to be closely related, and some historians even think they are the same god, named differently by ancient Italians living in different regions.

The main center of the ancient Lupercalia celebrations was the cave of the Lupercal on Rome's Palatine Hill. There, Romulus and Remus, the legendary founders of Rome, were supposedly nursed and brought up by a she-wolf. The Greek word for "wolf" is *lukos*, and the Latin name for the gray wolf is *canis lupus*, hence the terms "Lupercal," "Lupercus," and "Lupercalia." Some traditions even say that Romulus and Remus instituted the Lupercalia feast.

Space restrictions forbid going into the details of all the strange rituals performed at the Lupercalia, but a few are worth mentioning. One ritual had two young priests running almost naked (remember, this is in mid-February!) around the old city walls, slapping any bystanders they met with thongs cut from animals that had been sacrificed earlier. A smack from one of these thongs was supposed to cure sterility.

Another rite was a purification ceremony held during the Lupercalia, at which the priests of Pan Lyceus purified Roman women. Suffice it to say that the details of how this happened should not be repeated in mixed company!

Question 3: How did the Lupercalia transform into Valentine's Day?

The feast of Lupercalia was very important to the Romans, as was the feast of Faunalia to other Italians. The former is regarded as the oldest of the Roman festivals and, along with the Saturnalia, among the most significant. The import of this festival is borne out by the fact that a primary function of two of the most prominent families of the ancient Roman nobility, the Fabius and Quinctilius families, was to organize the annual Lupercalia festivities.

A modern parallel of this would be if a nation's President or Prime Minister were to dedicate two of his top cabinet officials and their entire staffs to the organization of the annual Saint Valentine's Day celebrations! Sound ridiculous? Nevertheless, that is how important the ancient Romans thought the Lupercalia was.

Firmly entrenched in Roman life, Lupercalia survived even the arrival of Christianity in Rome. The *Encyclopaedia Britannica* asserts, "The annual celebration of the Lupercalia went on until AD 494, when it was changed by Pope Gelasius I into . . . the feast of the Purification." Remember that a major ritual during the Lupercalia was the Roman women's purification by Pan Lyceus priests. Pope Gelasius I substituted his interpretation of God's post-pregnancy purification ceremony as a direct replacement for a heathen one!

The Roman Church initially observed the Feast of the Purification on February 14, forty days after Epiphany (January 6). The Armenian church still celebrates it on that date. Later, the Catholic Church moved it to February 2, forty days after Christmas (December 25), and the empty day on the liturgical calendar was filled, apparently arbitrarily, with the dedication of February 14 to the two Saint Valentines.

As an aside, in the Roman Church, virtually every day is a feast day in memory of one "saint" or another. Emperor Justinian established February 2 as the Feast of the Purification in AD 542, and today, some call it "Candlemas." It may be significant—and it seems too much of a coincidence not to be—that February 2 is also a prominent day for those who

practice witchcraft around the world. Strangely, it is also Groundhog Day in the United States and Canada.

Question 4: What does God think about it?

God warns His people literally hundreds of times in both the Old and New Testaments to stick to His ways, His laws, and His feasts, being careful to stay away from the pagan ways of the surrounding world. For example:

Take heed to yourself, lest you make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land where you are going, lest it be a snare in your midst. But you shall destroy their altars, break their sacred pillars, and cut down their wooden images (for you shall worship no other god, for the LORD, whose name is Jealous, is a jealous God), lest you make a covenant with the inhabitants of the land, and they play the harlot with their gods and make sacrifice to their gods, and one of them invites you and you eat of his sacrifice, and you take of his daughters for your sons, and his daughters play the harlot with their gods and make your sons play the harlot with their gods. You shall make no molded gods for yourselves. (Exodus 34:12-17)

Then, right after this instruction, God commands His people to keep *His* feasts: the Feast of Unleavened Bread (verse 18), the weekly Sabbath (verse 21), Pentecost, and the fall feasts (verse 22). Now notice Numbers 25:1-3:

Then Israel remained in Acacia Grove, and the people began to commit harlotry with the women of Moab. They invited the people to the sacrifices of their gods, and the people ate and bowed down to their gods. So, Israel was joined to Baal of Peor, and the anger of the LORD was aroused against Israel.

The Bible contains numerous warnings for God's children to cling to His ways and shun pagan ways with abhorrence. Were we to look up all the scriptures containing the word "gods," we would find hundreds of cautions and commands to avoid and forsake them! But probably no scripture in the whole Word of God puts it better than Deuteronomy 12:29-32:

When the LORD your God cuts off from before you the nations which you go to dispossess, and you have displaced them and dwell in their land, take heed to yourself that you are not ensnared to follow them, after they are destroyed from before you, and that you do not inquire after their gods, saying, "How did these nations serve their gods? I also will do likewise." You shall not worship the LORD your God in that way; for every abomination to the LORD which He hates they have done to their gods; for they burn even their sons and daughters in the fire to their gods. Whatever I command you, be careful to observe it; you shall not add to it nor take away from it.

Question 5: What should we do about it?

The Scriptures, even the few verses we have included here, are quite clear that those called into God's church should not keep Saint Valentine's Day. At best, it is an ancient pagan festival covered with a microscopically thin "Christian" veneer. The alternative is likewise clear: We must keep God's holy days with joy and zeal.

God gave the ancient Israelites the authority and responsibility to go into their new homeland and tear down all the places of pagan worship. He, of course, has not given us that authority and responsibility. We must make the best of living amid this thinly disguised paganism!

For most adults in God's church, Valentine's Day celebrations present few problems. In the unlikely event you receive an invitation to a Valentine's party, a simple "No, thank you" usually suffices. To avoid getting into a troublesome—and probably unnecessary discussion—plan in advance a couple of good reasons (true ones, of course!) why you cannot attend.

Our children, particularly the younger ones, have the most problems with avoiding Valentine's Day celebrations. High schoolers should be able to do their own advance preparations as the adults do. Most teens have been through it often enough to know what to expect and how to avoid it, but we cannot expect our younger children to handle it independently. They need help, parents!

Warning: Please do not rely on that ten-minute chat you had last August or September with your child's new teacher, during which you told her all about the Feast of Trumpets, the Day of Atonement, the Feast of Tabernacles, Halloween, Christmas, New Year's Day, Valentine's Day, Easter, and the Days of Unleavened Bread. Take some extra time shortly

before Valentine's Day to drop by the school for a friendly talk with the teacher (or teachers, as may be the case).

If you definitely cannot get to the school to see the teachers in person, write a friendly little note of explanation to each of them and send it along with your child[ren]. Remember to be nice! It is not the teacher's fault that the school's curriculum is built around the world's celebrations and holidays. Also, consider that they have not been given the ability to understand these things as we have. It was not that long ago that we, too, were "in the dark" on these matters!

Love for God

Most importantly, how can we tell God we love Him if we compromise with His instruction and observe this day, especially considering our understanding of its origins? He specifically commands:

Do not love the world or the things in the world. If anyone loves the world, the love of the Father is not in him. For all that is in the world—the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life—is not of the Father but is of the world. And the world is passing away, and the lust of it; but he who does the will of God abides forever. (I John 2:15-17)

We can be glad that God has freed us from the modern versions of the old pagan holidays. Paul reminds us, "No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life, that he may please Him who enlisted him as a soldier" (Il Timothy 2:4). As we take care not to entangle ourselves in the affairs and holidays of this world, we can instead focus our thoughts on God's revealed holy days and appreciate how observing them provides a unique understanding of Christ's marvelous work and God's plan for both us and the rest of mankind.

This should make us realize how much He has given us, motivating us to keep His true Sabbaths and holy days more effectively and appreciatively. So, how can we show God we truly love Him? His Word in I John 2:3, 5 tells us, "Now by this we know that we know Him, if we keep His commandments. . . . Whoever keeps His word, truly the love of God is perfected in him."

That love is *real* love!

In an open letter to the U.S. Catholic bishops, Pope Francis rebuked the Trump administration for its deportation of illegal

immigrants. Francis insisted that assigning criminality to illegal status is contrary to Christianity and warned that such an approach will "end badly."

This is not the first time the pope has taken issue with Trump and his approach to immigration. In 2016 Francis held a mass near the Texas/Mexico border where Trump was planning the building of the border wall. He afterwards declared that anyone who builds a wall, rather than a bridge, to keep out migrants "is not a Christian."

Trump's Border Czar, Tom Homan, who is a lifelong Catholic, took Francis to task and rebuked him for his criticisms. Here are three reasons Homan is right to rebuke the pope.

Reason #1

He's Too Far Removed from the Situation

Is it not strange that an Argentinian pope who resides in splendor in Rome feels he has the right to instruct America how to handle its border crisis and immigration system? In his response to the pope's criticism, Homan said, "I have harsh words for the pope. He ought to fix the Catholic Church, and concentrate on his work, and leave border enforcement to us." As documented in my book, *Infallible Pope: Key to Unity or Source of Division*, the papal office has a long history of meddling in issues and with people that are of no concern to it.

Reason #2

The Border is Not His Concern

According to Roman Catholic doctrine, the pope derives his authority to speak from Peter through a long line of ecclesiastical succession. However, in Scripture, Peter is presented as a very fallible individual who denies the Lord (Luke 22:55-62), waffles concerning true doctrine (Galatians 2:11-14), and is rebuked by Jesus for trying to meddle in John's ministry and calling (John 21:20-22).

Concerning being rebuked by Jesus, this occurred in a post-resurrection appearance to His disciples recorded in John 21. In this appearance, Jesus addressed Peter and asked him three times, *Do you love Me?* When Peter answered in the affirmative, Jesus then exhorted him to *Feed My sheep* and to *Follow Me*.

Peter then turned, looked at John, and said to Jesus, *But Lord, what about this man?* With a gentle rebuke Jesus replied, *If I will that he remain till I come, what is that to you? You follow me* (John 21:22).

In other words, there were issues and things about other believers that did not concern Peter. John had a relationship with Jesus that was of no concern to Peter. Peter must give himself to his own task and not meddle in the affairs of others

In the spirit of the words of Jesus to Peter, Homan said of the pope, "I wish he would stick to the Catholic Church and fix that and leave border enforcement to us." Yes, as Jesus said to Peter when he meddled with John's business and calling, What is that to you? You follow Me!

Reason #3

His Actions Do Not Match His Words

The pope's words would carry more force if he practiced what he preaches. But while rebuking the Trump administration for its deportations and national security, he lives in splendor behind the high walls and tight security of the Vatican. Homan rhetorically asked, "So, he's got a wall to protect his people and himself, and we can't protect the people of the United States?"

Pope Francis reminds me of the wealthy elite on Martha's Vineyard who had proclaimed themselves a "sanctuary city." But when Governor Ron DeSantis bused illegal migrants to Martha's Vineyard, the residents there found a way to very quickly have them removed. It is like Hollywood elites who verbally champion the rights of the homeless and illegal migrants to live anywhere they choose . . . except inside the high walls of their gated communities.

Talk is cheap. Leaders must lead by their actions, not just their words. Otherwise, it comes across as mere "virtue signaling."

The Best Way to Lift the Poor

As Christians we have a responsibility to care for the homeless, the poor, and honest migrants who have been trapped in an unfortunate political situation. One way we do this is by direct charitable actions.

However, we do this on an even wider scale by supporting a form of government that lifts the poor by creating and maintaining a prosperous economy that provides opportunity and well-paying jobs for the greatest number of people. Millions of immigrants arrived to this land poor, but because of the opportunities afforded them, they discovered what has been called "the American Dream."

But to have such a government and economy, we must return to our founding principles of Faith and Freedom. We must have a secure border and a form of government that facilitates and encourages individual liberty and Christian morality. The church in America has a vital part to play if this is to be a reality once again.

The Key to America's Greatness

The vital role of the church in America's greatness was highlighted in a statement by the French sociologist, Alexis de Tocqueville, after a six month visit to America in 1831. He came to study the nation's penal system and see if he could discover the reason for the young nation's rapid rise to influence and power in the earth.

The following quote is not found in Tocqueville's writings, but it has been historically attributed to him and has the sound and feel of Tocqueville. It was probably included in one of his many lectures, which someone wrote down and it later found its way into the written narrative.

Arriving on the heels of the Second Great Awakening, Tocqueville recounted how he sought for America's greatness in her institutions of government, her educational system, her factories, harbors, and vast commerce. He then said,

Not until I went into the churches of America and heard her pulpits flame with righteousness did I understand the secret of her genius and power. America is great because America is good, and if America ever ceases to be good, America will cease to be great (Hyatt, *Pilgrims and Patriots, Second Edition*, 177).

America's problems stem from a devastating loss of morality, truth, and spirituality, and only an Awakened Church can resolve the current crises and Make America Great Again.

After John eats the little book or scroll, he is told, "You must prophesy **again** about many peoples, and nations, and tongues, and kings" (Revelation 10:11).
